

UE-1 CONSTRUCTION PROJECT 2005 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The UE-1 Project Scholarship is comprised of 4 scholarships available to relatives of UE-1 project construction workers who are students enrolled or accepted to a post secondary institution in Canada. The scholarship is available on a competitive basis in recognition of academic excellence.

Application Deadline
September 30, 2005

Award

1 scholarship valued at \$1,500.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant.
- Must be a direct relative to a full time construction employee of UE-1 who has worked at least 6 months at UE-1, is a construction worker employed as a General Foreman, Journeyman or Apprentice and working at UE-1 at the time of the application.
- To be eligible the applicant must be enrolled or accepted to a recognized educational institution in a program of study requiring at a minimum two-years of full time study.
- Grades or marks placing in the top quartile of current class or program.
- Mail completed application to the ABTC no later than September 30, 2005.
- **ALL APPLICANTS MUST INCLUDE TRANSCRIPTS OR GRADE REPORTS OF THEIR MOST RECENT MARKS WITH THEIR APPLICATIONS.**

Selection

Selection of scholarship recipients is made by the Alberta Building Trades Council. The selection criteria has been established by UE-1.

Recipients will be selected on the basis of their GPA in their last year of study.

Completed applications that meet the above criteria and are received or postmarked by the September 30, 2005 deadline will be reviewed by a committee of the Alberta Building Trades Council. Students selected to receive the scholarship will be notified by late October 2005.
